

## Rules for the Cafeteria

Each morning the students are asked to select their choice of lunch entree or to inform the teacher that they are buying lunch. We stress accuracy because that list becomes the only accounting of how much food is prepared and delivered to our school.

At lunchtime, assistants line up the children by their lunch selections and the food is distributed. Children use a PIN number to charge their accounts or they pay cash for their purchases. The cafeteria sells a variety of snacks and ice cream, too, which you may or may not want your child to buy. Please inform the cafeteria of any restrictions you wish to put on your child's account.



Students must sit in their assigned area

Students should speak quietly to those around them.

Students should walk at all times.

Students should keep the area clean and recycle.

No student may leave the cafeteria alone or without the permission of the assistants on duty.

Students should be courteous to all students and adults.

We ask the students to follow these important rules:

- *Keep your hands to yourself*    • *Eat your own lunch*
- *Do not share food or ask someone else for their food.*
- *Talk quietly*                      • *Walk*

We are aware of the many food allergies of our students. Those with peanut and tree nut allergies sit at least one or more seats away from any student who is eating PB&J. That student is asked to use a wipe or our Purell soap before leaving the cafeteria. The table is also wiped down by the assistants.
